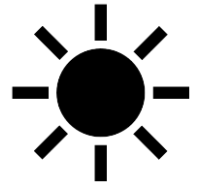




wild Worship

Walking distance: About 2.5 miles.

Walking time: With pauses for reflection, about 1 hour 45 mins.

Terrain: Mostly grass and paths; level overall with some gentle gradients; may be uneven and muddy underfoot.

Kit: Walking boots essential; waterproof clothing depending on the forecast

The Idea: The walk and worship will be led by John Hay and Nick Sissons. There will be suggested themes for reflection en route and a short act of worship. Please bring with you either a Bible passage or a poem/hymn/passage on the theme of Springtime. There will be an opportunity to share these.
